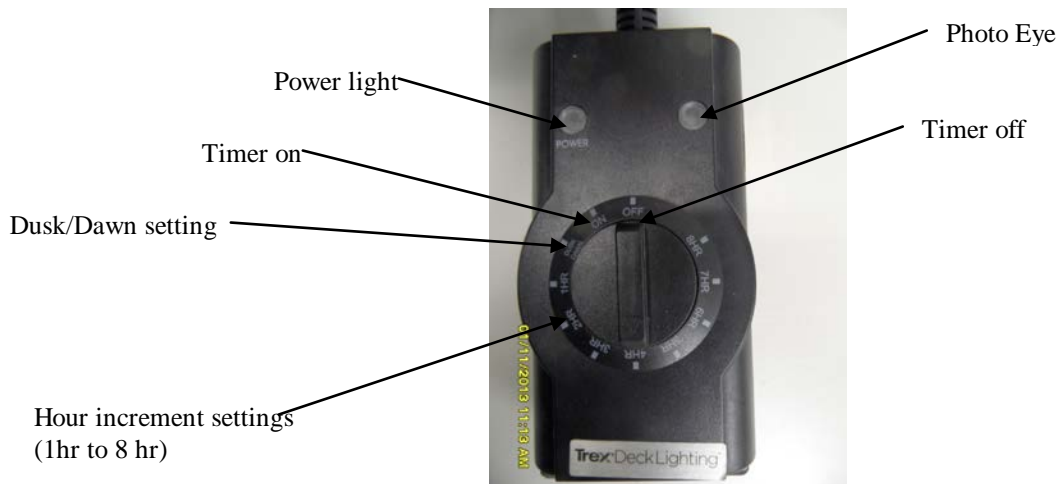

Trex Lighting – Timer Functions:



- When timer is set to OFF position the power light will be red and lights will be off.
- When timer is set to ON position the power light will be green and lights will be on:
 - Lights will be on constant (day and night) if this setting is left on.
- When timer is set to Dusk/Dawn setting:
 - Lights will be off during the day.
 - At dusk the Photo Eye will sense the lack of daylight and lights will turn on.
 - At dawn the Photo Eye will sense daylight and lights will turn off.
- When timer is set to any of the HR increment settings:
 - Lights will be off during the day.
 - At dusk the Photo Eye will sense the lack of daylight and lights will turn on.
 - Lights will remain on for the hour chosen. For example if the 3HR setting is on, lights will remain on for 3 hours, than turn off.
 - Lights will remain off until the Photo Eye again senses the lack of daylight, and the same would occur, lights would come on and remain on for 3 hours.
